SUMMARY: House Bill 2419, Printer's Number 2841, amends the Outpatient Psychiatric Oversight Act to allow required psychiatric time to be provided either in-person or through the use of telebehavioral health technology. This legislation is effective immediately upon enactment.

ANALYSIS: HB 2419 removes the statutory requirement that 50 percent of required psychiatric time be provided by an on-site psychiatrist. Under the bill, required time may be fulfilled either in-person or through the use of telebehavioral health technology.

The bill provides that nothing shall limit the ability of the Department of Human Services to issue regulation waivers.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation should have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
