SUMMARY: Designates a bridge carrying S.R. 3037 in Cambria County as the Reverend Andrew William Tilly, Jr., Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge carrying S.R. 3037, also known as William Penn Avenue, over the Norfolk Southern and Lehigh Valley Rail Management rail lines in the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, as the Reverend Andrew William Tilly, Jr., Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in current allocated funds.
