**SUMMARY**: Amends the Municipalities Planning Code to allow bond holders to draw down bonds as work is completed. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation amends Section 509 of the Municipalities Planning Code to change some provisions relating to bonding of projects as prerequisites to final plat approval.

The first change clarifies that a bond secured for a project cannot exceed 110% of the cost of the project.

The second change clarifies that prior to the completion of a project the bond can be drawn down to 10% of the estimated cost of the remaining improvements.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
