SUMMARY: Makes a correction to the Samuel Newman Way in East Stroudsburg Borough, Monroe County. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the portion of State Route 2014/Washington Street beginning at the intersection of South Courtland Street and Day Street at segment 0011 offset 1858 and ending at the intersection of Brown Street at segment 0011 offset 0000 in East Stroudsburg Borough, Monroe County, as the Samuel Newman Way.

PennDOT must erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

Section 18 of Act 102 of 2019 is repealed. This section incorrectly designated the portion of State Route 2012 South as the Samuel Newman Way.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
