### **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 1064 amends the Tax Increment Financing Act (P.L. 465, No. 113) by expanding eligible projects for Tax Increment Financing Districts.

# ANALYSIS:

This bill adds definitions for anti-displacement activities and area of impact, as well as updates the definitions of project and project costs to include anti-displacement activities in the tax increment district and area of impact. It adds anti-displacement activities to be included in project plans for each tax increment district and requires municipalities adopting a resolution or ordinance to create a tax increment financing district to describe any area of impact outside the district where anti-displacement activities may occur within the resolution or ordinance.

Finally, the bill extends the time a tax increment district may exist from 20 to 25 years.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

# **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This legislation would have no fiscal impact on the commonwealth.
