SUMMARY:

House Bill 1168 changes the requirements for two of The State System of Higher Education (PASSHE)'s Board of Governors members.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1168 amends Article XX-A – The State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) – of the Public School Code by making changes to the makeup of PASSHE's 20-member Board of Governors.

Concerning the governor's appointees, the bill reduces the number of members from five to three that must be selected from trustees of constituent institutions. In their place, the bill requires the governor to select a current or retired member from each of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) and the Association of Pennsylvania State College and University Faculties (APSCUF) that is recommended by the respective bargaining unit.

This bill would take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1168 will have no negative impact on commonwealth funds.
