#### SUMMARY:

Expands the membership of existing boards of inspectors for county jails and allows second class A counties to choose the board of inspector method of governing county prison facilities.

#### ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1509 amends Title 61 Section 1731(a) to allow county jail boards of inspectors to appoint two to four additional members to the board. These members must be residents of the county for which the board is established. The legislation also amends 1731(b) to allow second class A counties advanced before October 1, 2021, to choose the board of inspector method of governing county prison facilities.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on commonwealth funds.
