SUMMARY:

House Bill 1990 makes seizure recognition and related first aid training a requirement for school nurses.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1990 amends Article XIV – School Health Services – of the Public School Code by making changes to Section 1414.11 – Seizure Recognition and Related First Aid Training.

For school nurses, the bill changes the optional annual training for seizure recognition and related first aid training into a required biennial training. The bill clarifies that the training does not establish or expand civil liability on the part of a school entity or school employee.

This bill would take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1168 will have no negative impact on commonwealth funds. To the extent school entities bear any of the cost of school nurse training, this bill may impose a minimal cost on school entities.
