SUMMARY:

House Bill 2185 amends the Public School Code to provide Type 1 Diabetes Education Parental Notification.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2185 amends Article XIV – School Health Services – of the Public School Code by adding Section 1414.12 – Type 1 Diabetes Education Parental Notification.

The Department of Health is required to develop type 1 diabetes informational materials for parents and guardians and post the materials on its website. The type 1 diabetes informational materials may include a description of the warning signs, risk factors, screening process, and stages as well as recommendations for when to see a provider. School entities and nonpublic schools must make the informational materials available to parents, which can be accomplished by posting them on the school's website.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 2185 will have no fiscal impact on commonwealth funds. It is anticipated that the department can develop and provide the required educational materials as part of their current operations. School entities and nonpublic schools may incur a minimal cost if they choose to provide parents with physical copies of the educational materials.
