SUMMARY:

Amends the Judicial Code to place a cap on the costs of obtaining electronic medical records pursuant to a subpoena.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2198, Printer's Number 3320 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) Section 6152 to place a cap of \$200 on the costs of medical records requested in an electronic format pursuant to a subpoena.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on commonwealth funds.
