#### SUMMARY:

This legislation amends the definition of marriage to be a civil contract between two individuals.

#### ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2269 amends the definition of "marriage" in Section 1102 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes. The amended definition of "marriage" is a civil contract between two individuals.

The legislation also repeals Section 1704 of Title 23. Section 1704 voids marriage between persons of the same sex and declares that the public policy of the Commonwealth is that marriage shall be between one man and one woman.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
