SUMMARY: HB 2286 PN 3093 expands the immunity and liability of donated food that is still fit for human consumption. This legislation takes effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Act 76 of 1981 (Donated Food Limited Liability Act) to limit the civil and criminal liability for persons who donate food that is past the labeled date code recommended by the manufacturer but is still fit for human consumption. The person who donates the food must make a good faith evaluation that the donated food is good for human consumption. Immunity does not extend to persons who negligently or intentionally donate food and cause damage.

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation would not have a fiscal impact on Commonwealth Funds, specifically the General Fund.
