SUMMARY:

House Bill 2288 amends the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69), known as the Second Class Township Code, to update the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class.

ANALYSIS:

This bill updates the annual maximum compensation of supervisors of a township of the second class based on population as follows:

Township Population	Annual Maximum Compensation	
Not more than 4,999	\$3,145	
5,000 to 9,999	\$4,190	
10,000 to 14,999	\$5,450	
15,000 to 24,999	\$6,915	
25,000 to 34,999	\$7,353	
35,000 or more	\$8,385	

The bill also allows supervisors to be paid on a per-meeting basis based on attendance of the meeting. Total annual compensation shall not exceed the amounts specified in above for supervisors paid on a per-meeting basis. Compensation is not payable if a supervisor is absent from a meeting unless it is decided the absence was an excused absence.

Should a board of supervisors determine that supervisors shall receive compensation on a per-meeting basis, that determination must be made by ordinance.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation would have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
