**SUMMARY:** HB 2301 PN 3113 eliminates the statutory expiration date for a Distracted Driving Awareness license plate and makes it permanent. This legislation will take effect immediately.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicles) Section 1358.2 (related to distracted driving awareness plate) to remove the December 31, 2025, expiration date, and make the plate permanent.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The enactment of this legislation would have a *de minimis* fiscal impact on commonwealth funds, specifically the Motor License Fund. By making the plate permanent, PennDOT would continue to receive proceeds from issuance of such plates. As a reference, the department has collected \$2,787 since 2018/19.
