SUMMARY: HB 2364 PN 3445 provides a refundable registration fee for motorcycle safety education program courses. This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Title 75 (Vehicles) Section 7911 (Motorcycle Safety Education Program) to direct PennDOT to charge a nominal registration fee, not to exceed \$50, for courses offered through the Motorcycle Safety Education Program that will be refunded to the registrant, if the individual attends the course. Language also provides that any registration fees that were not refunded, must be deposited into the Motor Safety Education Account.

Additionally, the bill requires PennDOT to issue a report that provides an analysis of refunding the registration fee for motorcycle safety education course. Language articulates for the following components to be included in the report:

- Number of individuals who have completed such course prior to the enactment of this legislation;
- Number of who have enrolled in such course and who have failed to attend, prior to the enactment of this legislation;
- Number of individuals who have completed such course after the enactment of this legislation;
- Number of who have enrolled in such course and who have failed to attend, after the enactment of this legislation;
- Amount of fees refunded;
- Amount of fees deposited into the Motorcycle Safety Education Account; and
- Recommendations for legislative improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation would have a de minimis fiscal impact on Commonwealth Funds, specifically the Motor License Fund. While the bill provides for refund of fees, those refunds would have been submitted initially to the department, to attend the Motorcycle Safety Education Program.
