#### **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 2383 establishes the Older Adult Mentor Volunteer Program (MVP) Act.

### ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2383 establishes the Older Adult Mentor Volunteer Program (MVP) to expand opportunities for qualified older adult volunteers to work directly with students on school premises before, during, and after school.

The Department of Education (PDE) is required to establish guidelines in consultation with the State Board and the Department of Aging. To the extent funding is available, PDE shall develop and maintain an online registry to facilitate matching adults with students and schools. The applications are administered by the intermediate units.

House Bill 2383 would take effect in 60 days.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The requirements in House Bill 2383 are subject to available funds. The cost of the program will be limited to its funding amount. This bill does not include any funding, so there is no fiscal impact on the commonwealth.
