SUMMARY: HB 2451 PN 3441 eliminates prohibitions and limitations for Certified Poultry Technicians. This legislation will take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Act 466 of 1955 (Poultry Technician Licensure Law) by making the following changes:

- Provides for the ability of Secretary of Agriculture to license Certified Poultry Technicians as necessary.
 - Secretary may establish the following through the issuance of General Quarantine:
 - licensing and certification standards
 - regulatory sampling and testing procedures
- Enables any legal U.S. resident to become Certified Poultry Technician.
- Allows current Certified Poultry Technicians to take samples from birds on the farm where they work, which is currently prohibited.
- Aligns fee structure within the Poultry Technician Licensure Law to match Section 602-A(7) of the Administrative Code of 1929.

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact of HB 2451 is indeterminate. While the bill simply makes technical changes and provides for allowances and abilities of the Secretary of Agriculture, the number of instances where this could occur is unknown.
