**SUMMARY:** HB 2583 PN 3643 requires that Pennsylvania Game Commission officers be classified and compensated the same as members of the Pennsylvania State Police. This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Title 34 (Game) Section 303 (Game Commission officers and employees) to require that each full-time officer of the Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) be classified in the same manner as members of the Pennsylvania State Police for purposes of compensation.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The enactment of this legislation would have a fiscal impact on commonwealth funds, specifically the Game Fund. The Game Commission anticipates an approximate impact of \$3 million in fiscal year 2024/25 and \$5 million for fiscal year 2025/26. This will result in salary adjustments for the agency's over full time 200 officers.
