SUMMARY: HB 2610 PN 3698 removes the requirement that cremation equipment have an interlock system. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: Legislation amends Act 26 of 2024 (Crematory Regulations Act) to remove the requirement that crematory incinerators have an interlock system that precludes charging of the primary chamber until the secondary or last chamber temperature is holding at 1,600 degrees Fahrenheit.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on commonwealth funds.
