SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 142, Printer's Number 118 amends the Funeral Director Law to remove the requirement from the underlying bill that a widow or widower remain unmarried to continue to utilize a deceased spouse's funeral director license.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation amends Act 522 of 1952, known as the Funeral Director Law, by removing the stipulation that a widow or widower must remain unmarried to obtain and renew the license for the deceased estate issued by the State Board of Funeral Directors after the death of a licensee.

This legislation shall take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation removes the requirement for a widow or widower to remain unmarried to keep the license issued after the death of a licensee. Enactment of this legislation would have no fiscal impact to the commonwealth.
