SUMMARY:

This legislation changes the definition of “child pornography” in the Child Internet Protection Act.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 186 changes the definition of “child pornography” in the Child Internet Protection Act (Act 197 of 2004) to “child sexual abuse material.”

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
