SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 1005 makes an appropriation to the Office of Consumer Advocate for the 2024/25 fiscal year.

ANALYSIS:

The bill appropriates \$6.752 million from a restricted revenue account in the General Fund to the Office of Consumer Advocate within the Office of Attorney General. This is the same amount as the prior fiscal year and equal to the governor's proposal.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2024, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 1005 will cost the restricted revenue account within the General Fund \$6,752,000 in the 2024-25 fiscal year.
