**SUMMARY:** SB 1144 PN 1787 designates multiple roads and bridges throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation designates multiple roads and bridges as follows:

- PFC Dr. Alex W. Barber Memorial Bridge in Cambria County;
- Trooper First Class Brad Wilson Honorary Bridge in Clearfield County;
- LCPL Ralph J. Fabbri USMC Memorial Bridge in Blair County;
- Mayor Gerald D. Lucia Memorial Highway in Westmoreland County;
- CPL Reid Rex Ross 3 BN 26 Marine Reg. Memorial Bridge in Cambria County;
- Walter Skubel Memorial Bridge in Schuylkill County;
- Raphael Rivera Memorial Bridge in Northampton County;
- Lance Corporal Jason Frye Memorial Bridge in Perry County;
- Major General Edward C. Shannon Memorial Bridge in Lancaster County;
- CPL Patrick C. Farrell and PVT James J. Farrell Memorial Bridge in Blair County;
- SGM Charles B. Mills, Sr. Memorial Bridge Blair County;
- PFC Charles Shore Greenland Memorial Bridge in Huntingdon County;
- PFC Wasco (Spider) Pawuk Memorial Bridge in Huntingdon County;
- Corporal Carl Lynn Walker Memorial Bridge in Somerset County;
- Lance Corporal John F. Muffler Memorial Bridge in Bucks County;
- Senator Noah W. Wenger Memorial Highway in Lancaster County;
- Cpl. Jarrid L. King Memorial Bridge in Erie County;
- Captain Leroy Freeman Berkebile Memorial Bridge in Somerset County;
- PFC Wallace Rice Memorial Bridge in Cambria County;
- Lance Corporal Robert Alan "Bucky" McPherson Memorial Bridge in Washington County; and
- Senator David J. Arnold, Jr., Memorial Bridge in Lebanon County.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The fiscal impact from enactment of this legislation would be a function of the number of designations of roads and bridges within the legislation. The fiscal impact on Commonwealth Funds would be realized within the Motor License Fund. According to the Department of Transportation, the designation of a road or a bridge would require the installation of two signs, costing \$500.00. The legislation makes 21 road and bridge designations, resulting in a cost of \$21,500 to PennDOT.
