SUMMARY: SB 1144 PN 1801 designates multiple roads and bridges throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The fiscal impact from enactment of this legislation would be a function of two components, designation of a road or a bridge and the addition of one new position within the Department of Transportation, to handle the administrative component of such designations. The fiscal impact on Commonwealth Funds would be realized within the Motor License Fund. The components of the fiscal impact are as follows:

- Road and Bridge designations - \$30,000
- Addition of a Sr. Traffic Control Specialist position, including salary and benefits - \$107,000
  - For 2024/25 the cost would be \$53,500, since it would take time to hire the position
  - For 2025/26 the cost would be \$107,000
