DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1970, as amended, amends Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to provide for an exemption from vehicle registration and limits on number of towed vehicles.

Specifically, this legislation does the following:

- Amends §1302 by exempting any portable traffic control signal or device upon a trailer not exceeding 3,000 pounds gross vehicle weight from registration.
- Amends §4904 by adding a subsection that permits the above mentioned trailers to be towed in tandem as long as the length of the two trailers combined does not exceed 300 inches and the trailers are designed by the manufacturer to be able to be towed in tandem on public roadways.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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FISCAL IMPACT:

According to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the enactment of this legislation will have no adverse effect on Commonwealth funds.
