DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 743 establishes a new subsection (b.1) in Section 1519 (Teaching of Safe Driving of Motor Vehicles) in the Public School Code to permit a person who is not a certified teacher to teach driver education in public schools, if the person is qualified to teach driver education under the Private Driver Education or Training School Act and meets existing health, fitness and safety requirements for teachers contained in the law.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of Senate Bill 743 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
