DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1263 provides a requirement that the total amount appropriated for the "Reed Act – Employment Insurance" and the "Reed Act – Employment and Unemployment Insurance" shall not exceed the limitation provided in section 903 of the Social Security Act.

This requirement has been provided in the annual budgetary implementation section of the Fiscal Code in past fiscal years. Senate Bill 1263 moves the requirement from the annual section to the permanent section of the Fiscal Code so that this language does not have to be repeated in the annual budgetary implementation section of the Fiscal Code each year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The requirement concerning the limitation on these appropriations has been provided in the annual budgetary implementation section of the Fiscal Code in each fiscal year. No fiscal impact will result from moving the requirement to the permanent section of the Fiscal Code to eliminate this repetitive provision in the annual section of the Fiscal Code each year.
