DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 526 amends Sections 2501 (Definitions) and 2502 (Sanitation Standards) of Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidates Statutes to allow an Interstate or Pennsylvanian health certificate prepared by a veterinarian to be accepted as documentation to allow participation in a livestock show or exhibit.

Presently, the law requires an exhibitor to present a signed form self-certifying the animal has a veterinary-client-patient relationship.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Department of Agriculture has indicated that the enactment of Senate Bill 526 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
