DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1061 provides for the Commonwealth's non-preferred appropriation to the University of Pittsburgh for Fiscal Year 2020-21.

The legislation specifies \$151,507,000 shall be provided for General Support and \$3,346,000 for Rural Education Outreach, and payments to the university are to be made on a monthly basis.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT

Senate Bill 1061 will cost the Commonwealth a total of \$154,853,000 in Fiscal Year 2020-21. That preliminary funding amount is level with last year's budget and is identical to the Governor's proposed level. The appropriation will be revised when a final funding amount for Fiscal Year 2020-21 is determined.
