**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 1183 amends the Cosmetology Law to authorize licensed cosmetology schools to provide a portion of instruction through distance education.

This legislation allows a school of cosmetology to offer up to 50% of its curriculum in theory-based subjects through distance education, and it specifies that the curriculum at a school of cosmetology may not offer practical demonstrations through distance education.

House Bill 1183 defines "distance education" to include curriculum offered by a school of cosmetology to a student while the student is at a location separate and apart from the school.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The implementation of the provisions of House Bill 1183 can be accomplished within existing staffing and funding levels provided to the Department of State for the State Board of Cosmetology.
