**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 2361 amends Title 38 (Holidays and Observances) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to include an additional veteran recognition day.

Title 38 is amended by adding a new § 1304 (relating to Women Veterans Day) to recognize the contributions of women veterans of the United States Armed Forces from this Commonwealth. This legislation designates June 12 of each year as "Women Veterans Day" in this Commonwealth.

Additionally, this legislation requires the Governor to issue annually a proclamation encouraging residents of the Commonwealth to observe Women Veterans Day and recognize the contributions of all women veterans and the sacrifices they made.

This act shall take effect immediately.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
