DESCRIPTION

House Bill 2484 amends Title 65 (Public Officers) to require the submission of a statement of financial disclosure with regard to write-in candidates.

This bill requires a write-in candidate to file a statement of financial interest within 30 days of having been nominated or elected unless the person declines the nomination or office within that period of time.

The statement of financial interest shall be filed with the State Ethics Commission for state-level public office or with the governing authority of the political subdivision in which that person has been elected or nominated for county or local-level office.

The 30-day period shall be calculated from the date of the certification of the person as the winner of a nomination or election.

If the write-in candidate is nominated and fails to file a statement of financial interest, the write-in candidate shall not appear on the ballot.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 2484 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth or local funds.
