DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 208 amends the Municipal Planning Code to clarify bonding requirements for property improvements.

This bill clarifies that a municipality may not require a developer to post a bond of greater than 110% of the costs of the improvements. It also clarifies that a municipality may retain 110% of the remaining costs of improvements prior to completion.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 208 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
