DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 675 amends the Third Class City Code to make changes to the appointment of city administrators.

This bill allows city council to appoint a partnership, limited partnership, association or professional corporation as the city administrator pursuant to a professional services agreement. Any employees who directly provide services to the city as part of the appointed partnership, limited partnership, association or professional corporation are prohibited from holding any elected city office.

Only an individual who is appointed as the city administrator may also serve as the city chief fiscal officer. Only an individual that is appointed city administrator must receive permission from the city council to reside outside the city.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 675 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. There are 53 cities of third class in the Commonwealth that would be affected by this legislation. This legislation is not anticipated to have any fiscal impact on the affected municipalities.
