DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1199 amends the Port of Pittsburgh Commission Act to modernize the composition of the commission.

This bill changes the make up of the Port of Pittsburgh Commission (commission) board to be composed of individuals 18 years of age or older and to include:

- Four members appointed by the Governor to a four-year term;
- Three members appointed by the Governor from a list submitted by the Southwestern Pennsylvania Regional Planning Commission to a two-year term;
- One member appointed by the Governor from a list submitted by the commission to a two-year term;
- One member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
- One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;
- One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives;
- One member nominated by the commission's Executive Committee and appointed by the commission's board to a two-year term.

This bill shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 1199 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The governing body of the commission is currently comprised of 15 members, and the proposed legislation reduces that number to 13. The commission may realize modest savings as a result of the reduction in the number of commission members.
