DESCRIPTION

House Bill 73 amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a special registration plate to veterans of Operation Inherent Resolve. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

This legislation is scheduled to take effect in 120 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

According to the Department of Transportation, enactment of this legislation will cost a total of \$15,000, including \$14,500 for system changes and \$500 for the special registration plate design. The department indicates these costs are capable of being accommodated within the agency's current workload and budget.

A person applying for the special registration plate must include a fee of \$26 in addition to the registration fee. The amount of additional revenue generated by the special plate fee will be dependent on the number of special registration plates issued.
