## DESCRIPTION

House Bill 2294 amends the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act to expand the definition of "primary supervising physician" to include a medical doctor that is licensed with the State Board of Medicine.

By amending the definition of "primary supervising physician", the legislation allows a physician assistant to work with either an osteopathic physician licensed with the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine or a medical doctor licensed with the State Board of Medicine.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

According to information provided by the Department of State, implementation costs related to House Bill 2294 can be accommodated within existing funding levels.
