DESCRIPTION

House Bill 2295 amends the Medical Practice Act of 1985 to expand the definition of “primary supervising physician” to include an osteopathic doctor licensed by the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

By amending the definition of “primary supervising physician”, the legislation allows a physician assistant to work with either a medical doctor licensed by the State Board of Medicine or an osteopathic doctor licensed by the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

According to information provided by the Department of State, implementation costs related to House Bill 2295 can be accommodated within existing funding levels.
