DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 366 amends Section 2502.8 (Payments on Account of Pupils Enrolled in Career and Technical Curriculums) of the Public School Code to require the data used to calculate the annual distribution of the Secondary Career & Technical Education subsidy to be fixed as of the first day of June preceding the school year in which the allocation occurs.

The legislation requires the Department of Education to revise the data if it is subsequently found to be incorrect.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT

The enactment of Senate Bill 366 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Funding for the Secondary Career and Technical Education subsidy is dependent on appropriations made by the General Assembly in the General Appropriation Act.
