DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1008 appropriates \$2,269,000 from the Philadelphia Taxicab and Limousine Regulatory Fund to the Philadelphia Parking Authority (authority) for Fiscal Year 2024-25.

The Philadelphia Taxicab and Limousine Regulatory Fund was created by Act 64 of 2013 to act as the primary operating fund for the Philadelphia Parking Authority to regulate taxicabs and limousines in the city of the first class. Revenues in the fund are derived from assessments and fees to taxicab, limousine and dispatcher utility groups. Monies in the fund are used by the authority for administration and enforcement of the taxicab and limousine program.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2024, or immediately, whichever is later.
