Co-Sponsorship of Legislation – Post Employment Restriction Language

In the near future, I will introduce three bills that are a part of the House Democrats' Good Government Package. My legislative intent is to prevent "pay-to-play" politics and prohibit the revolving door between government service and special interests. The bills are:

- H.B. 112 would amend the Admin Code to prohibit Secretaries and Deputy Secretaries with regulatory or licensing authority from accepting employment or receiving compensation of fees for services from a business or entity they regulated or licensed for 2 years after they leave their position.
- **H.B.** 113 would amend the Ethics Act to prohibit Executive-level State employee with regulatory or licensing authority from accepting employment or receiving compensation of fees for services from a business or entity they regulated or licensed for 2 years after they leave their position.
- H.B. 114 would amend the Admin Code to prohibit an individual employed by a regulated/licensed industry/entity from accepting nomination or appointment to a Secretary or Deputy Secretary position which would regulate/license the industry/entity for 2 years after terminating employment with the regulated/licensed industry/entity.
