Co-sponsorship Legislation on Finder's Fee

In the near future I will be introducing legislation that will enable the Commonwealth to incentivize current Pennsylvania businesses to develop new employment opportunities by encouraging and recruiting their out-of-state suppliers, customers or other possible associated businesses to relocate to Pennsylvania. A successful intermediary business or "Sponsor Firm" and the "New Business Firm" would both be compensated by a "Finder's Fee" in the form of a \$500 per job tax credit from the Commonwealth.

Typically, a finder's fee is compensation to an intermediary in a business transaction where the two partners in a transaction would not have met if it was not for the work of the intermediary. Pennsylvania's business community is the Commonwealth's own intermediary with a vast rolodex of out-of-state, national and international, networks. Pennsylvania should partner with its business community to utilize their relationships and partnerships in order to bring out-of-state businesses into the Commonwealth to create new employment opportunities for its citizens.

The relocation of new businesses would result in job creation, an expanded tax base and increased tax revenues, and strengthened supply networks.
