He joined the Negro Ensemble Company where he appeared in Off Broadway productions. Later he joined Vinnette Carroll's Urban Arts Company. In 1970, Mr. Hemsley was casted as the character Gitlow in the Broadway musical "Purlie." As a result of his stellar performance as Gitlow, Mr. Hemsley was introduced to television audiences as Archie Bunker's neighbor, George Jefferson in "All in the Family," in 1973.

Mr. Hemsley's role as George Jefferson became so popular among television audiences that it led to a spinoff series entitled, "The Jeffersons" which debuted in January of 1975. "The Jeffersons" remained a household favorite for eleven seasons through 1985. Mr. Hemsley continued his television career starring as Deacon Ernest Frye in the series "Amen" beginning in 1986. "Amen" ran for five seasons until 1991. In addition to his acting career, Mr. Hemsley was an accomplished jazz keyboardist; releasing a single entitled, "Ain't That a Kick in the Head."
