## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain

- 9 Section 1. Section 696 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by 10
- adding a subsection to read: 11
- 12 Section 696. Distress in School Districts of the First
- Class.--\* \* \* 13
- (n.3) (1) At the first primary, special or general election 14
- that occurs at least ninety (90) days after the effective date 15
- of this subsection, a binding referendum question shall be 16
- presented to the electors of the school district of the first 17
- 18 class, which referendum shall ask, as a single ballot question,
- whether the School Reform Commission shall be dissolved and the 19

- 1 members of the board of school directors for the school district
- 2 shall be elected, on a nonpartisan basis, by the qualified
- 3 <u>electors</u>.
- 4 (2) If a majority of the qualified electors votes in favor
- 5 of the dissolution of the School Reform Commission and the
- 6 public election of members of the board of school directors,
- 7 then the dissolution shall be effective at least one hundred
- 8 eighty (180) days prior to the end of the current school year
- 9 and shall be effective at the end of that school year.
- 10 (3) The election of members of the board of school directors
- 11 shall occur as soon as practicable in order for the elected
- 12 members to take office prior to the commencement of the
- 13 <u>following school year.</u>

- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
