AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 8, 1959 (P.L.1718, No.632), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the payment of 2 the salary, medical and hospital expenses of employes of State penal and correctional institutions, State mental 3 4 hospitals, Youth Development Centers, County Boards of 5 6 Assistance, and under certain conditions other employes of the Department of Public Welfare, who are injured in the 7 performance of their duties; and providing benefit to their 8 9 widows and dependents in certain cases, " providing for a limitation on salary payments to employees. 10
- 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 12 hereby enacts as follows:
- 13 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of December 8, 1959
- 14 (P.L.1718, No.632), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for
- 15 the payment of the salary, medical and hospital expenses of
- 16 employes of State penal and correctional institutions, State
- 17 mental hospitals, Youth Development Centers, County Boards of
- 18 Assistance, and under certain conditions other employes of the
- 19 Department of Public Welfare, who are injured in the performance
- 20 of their duties; and providing benefit to their widows and
- 21 dependents in certain cases, " amended September 2, 1961

- 1 (P.L.1224, No.534), is amended to read:
- 2 Section 1. Any employe of a State penal or correctional
- 3 institution under the Bureau of Correction of the Department of
- 4 Justice and any employe of a State mental hospital or Youth
- 5 Development Center under the Department of Public Welfare, who
- 6 is injured during the course of his employment by an act of any
- 7 inmate or any person confined in such institution or by any
- 8 person who has been committed to such institution by any court
- 9 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or by any provision of the
- 10 "Mental Health Act" and any employe of County Boards of
- 11 Assistance injured by act of an applicant for or recipient of
- 12 public assistance and any employe of the Department of Public
- 13 Welfare who has been assigned to or who has volunteered to join
- 14 the fire fighting force of any institution of the Department of
- 15 Public Welfare injured while carrying out fire fighting duties,
- 16 shall be paid, by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, his full
- 17 salary[,] for no more than three years from the date of the
- 18 <u>injury</u>, or until the disability arising therefrom no longer
- 19 prevents his return as an employe of such department, board or
- 20 institution at a salary equal to that earned by him at the time
- 21 of his injury, whichever is sooner.
- 22 All medical and hospital expenses incurred in connection with
- 23 any such injury shall be paid by the Commonwealth of
- 24 Pennsylvania until the disability arising from such injury no
- 25 longer prevents his return as an employe of such department,
- 26 board or institution at a salary equal to that earned by him at
- 27 the time of his injury.
- During the time salary for such disability shall be paid by
- 29 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania any workmen's compensation
- 30 received or collected for such period shall be turned over to

- 1 the Commonwealth and paid into the General Fund, and if such
- 2 payment shall not be so made, the amount so due the Commonwealth
- 3 shall be deducted from any salary then or thereafter becoming
- 4 due and owing.
- 5 The widow and minor dependents of any employe who dies within
- 6 one year as a result of such injuries shall be paid benefits
- 7 equal to fifty per cent of the full salary of the deceased
- 8 employe.
- 9 When a widow and minor dependents not in her custody are
- 10 entitled to payments, one-half of such payments shall be paid to
- 11 the widow and one-half to the dependents. In every case the
- 12 amount payable to minor dependents shall be divided equally
- 13 among them and be paid to the persons or institutions having
- 14 custody of them.
- In the case of a widow or a widow with minor dependents in
- 16 her custody, such benefits shall terminate when such widow
- 17 remarries. In the case of minor dependents, except when in the
- 18 custody of a remarried widow, such benefits shall terminate when
- 19 all of the minor dependents become eighteen years of age.
- 20 Neither a widow nor minor dependents shall receive any benefits
- 21 under this act while receiving benefits under the Federal Social
- 22 Security Law. The benefits provided by this act shall be reduced
- 23 by the amount of any workmen's compensation benefits received or
- 24 collected by any such widow or minor dependents because of the
- 25 same injury. Payments for the benefit of minor dependents shall
- 26 be made to the person having legal custody of them.
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
