AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 1 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 2 3 4 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing 5 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 7 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties, " providing for gaming privilege assessment; and 10 establishing the Public Education Improvement Fund. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding an article to 15 16 read: 17 ARTICLE XVI-B.1 GAMING PRIVILEGE ASSESSMENT

- Section 1601-B.1. Scope. 19
- 20 This article relates to assessments on net gambling income.
- 21 Section 1602-B.1. Definitions.
- 22 The following words and phrases when used in this article

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Department." The Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth.
- 4 "Gambling losses." The term includes losses incurred from
- 5 lotteries, raffles, horse races and casinos.
- 6 "Gross gambling income." The term includes:
- 7 (1) Winnings from lotteries, raffles, horse races and
- 8 <u>casinos</u>.
- 9 (2) Cash winnings.
- 10 (3) The fair market value of prizes.
- "Net gambling income." The term includes gross gambling
- 12 income minus gambling losses properly claimed under the Internal
- 13 Revenue Code (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 1 et seq.) and
- 14 itemized on IRS Form 1040, Schedule A.
- 15 "Payer." The individual or entity responsible for
- 16 remunerating net qambling income to the maker of a wager.
- 17 "Secretary." The Secretary of Revenue of the Commonwealth.
- 18 "Single event." The result of a single wager placed
- 19 irrespective of amount wagered, including a single spin, dealt
- 20 hand, race or similar event.
- 21 Section 1603-B.1. Assessment.
- 22 (a) Imposition. -- In addition to any tax imposed by the
- 23 Commonwealth under Article III, an assessment is imposed on all
- 24 net qambling income earned as a result of a waqer placed in this
- 25 Commonwealth. The provisions of Article III shall apply to the
- 26 tax.
- 27 (b) Rate. -- The assessment imposed under subsection (a) shall
- 28 be a percentage assessment of 5% of the amount of the net
- 29 gambling income earned by the individual.
- 30 (c) Noncash income. -- Gambling income not paid in cash shall

- 1 be valued at its fair market value as determined by the
- 2 secretary.
- 3 (d) Payment.--Except as otherwise provided for under
- 4 subsection (f)(2) or (q), the assessment imposed under this
- 5 article shall be paid by the individual and remitted to the
- 6 department through a procedure determined by the secretary.
- 7 (e) Deposit.--The proceeds of the assessment imposed under
- 8 this article shall be deposited in the <u>Public Education</u>
- 9 Improvement Fund established under section 1604-B.1.
- (f) Payer duties. -- A payer shall have no duty to track,
- 11 report or otherwise administer the assessment, except that the
- 12 payer shall:
- 13 (1) forward information required by the Internal Revenue
- 14 Service to the department in a manner determined by the
- 15 secretary; and
- 16 (2) remit to the department an amount equal to the
- 17 appropriate amount of the assessment imposed under this
- article for all net gambling income of \$5,000 or more in a
- 19 <u>single event.</u>
- 20 (q) Voluntary withholding. -- The individual may elect to have
- 21 an appropriate amount of the assessment withheld by the payer
- 22 for remission to the department.
- 23 Section 1604-B.1. Public Education Improvement Fund.
- 24 (a) Establishment.--There is hereby established in the State
- 25 Treasury a special fund to be known as the Public Education
- 26 Improvement Fund, which shall receive money from the assessment
- 27 imposed under this article and any other money from any source
- 28 designated for deposit in the Public Education Improvement Fund.
- 29 (b) Use of money. -- Money in the Public Education Improvement
- 30 Fund shall be used for additional funding for all school

- 1 districts in this Commonwealth as specified by law and is
- 2 appropriated.
- 3 Section 2. The addition of Article XVI-B.1 of the act shall
- 4 apply to gross gambling income earned during taxable years
- 5 beginning after December 31, 2013.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
