AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, providing for
- 3 the sale of food, over-the-counter drugs and cosmetics after
- 4 expiration date.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 7332. Unlawful sale of certain foods, over-the-counter drugs
- and cosmetics after expiration date.
- 11 (a) Provisions.--No person, whether acting for himself or
- 12 for another, shall directly or indirectly sell or offer for
- 13 sale:
- 14 (1) Any over-the-counter drug, infant formula or baby
- food or any other food subject to expiration dating
- 16 requirements issued by the Federal Food and Drug
- 17 Administration, after the expiration, "use by" or "best
- 18 before" date on its label or packaging has passed.

- 1 (2) Any cosmetic or food after the expiration, "use by"
- 2 or "best before" date on its label or packaging has passed,
- 3 unless such cosmetic or food is offered for sale with
- 4 <u>information in clear and plain view of the consumer</u>
- 5 indicating that the cosmetic or food has passed its
- 6 expiration, "use by" or "best before" date. Such information
- 7 must be visible on the packaging or label of the expired
- 8 <u>cosmetic or food</u>. Any business that sells or offers for sale
- 9 <u>expired cosmetic or food pursuant to this subsection must</u>
- 10 physically separate all expired cosmetics and food from all
- 11 <u>unexpired cosmetics and food. The separated, expired products</u>
- must be offered for sale in close proximity to a clearly
- 13 <u>visible sign indicating that the cosmetics or food being</u>
- 14 <u>offered for sale in that location of the business has passed</u>
- the expiration, "use by or "best before" date.
- (b) Penalty.--Any person who violates this section is quilty
- 17 of a summary offense, punishable by a fine of not more than \$300
- 18 for each item sold or offered for sale after the expiration,
- 19 "use by" or "best before" date. The fine shall be calculated
- 20 <u>based upon the number of days past the expiration</u>, "use by" or
- 21 "best before" date that the product is either found being
- 22 offered for sale, or if the product in sold, the date of sale as
- 23 established by evidence of proof of purchase, including, but not
- 24 <u>limited to, a sales receipt.</u>
- 25 (c) Enforcement.--The department shall enforce and
- 26 <u>administer the provisions of this section.</u>
- 27 <u>(d) Administration.--The department shall promulgate rules</u>
- 28 and regulations to administer this section and may assess
- 29 <u>administrative</u> penalties on a person who violates this section
- 30 and when deemed necessary by the secretary, penalties may

- 1 include the revocation of any license, including a business
- 2 privilege license or sales license held by a person who operates
- 3 a business in violation of this section.
- 4 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 6 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 <u>"Baby food." The processing of canned fresh fruits and</u>
- 8 vegetables, meats, eggs, fruit juices, cereal, formulated
- 9 entrees, desserts and snacks using fresh, preprocessed or any
- 10 combination of these and other food ingredients necessary for
- 11 the production of foods for consumption by a child under two
- 12 years of age.
- 13 "Department." The Department of Agriculture of the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- "Infant formula." A food which purports to be or is
- 16 represented for special dietary use solely as a food for infants
- 17 by reason of its simulation of human milk or its suitability as
- 18 a complete or partial substitute for human milk.
- 19 "Over-the-counter drug." A nonprescription drug regulated by
- 20 the Federal Food and Drug Administration that is required to
- 21 have an expiration date on its packaging pursuant to the Federal
- 22 law and Federal regulations adopted pursuant to the Federal act,
- 23 including, but not limited to, Federal regulations.
- 24 <u>"Secretary." The Secretary of Agriculture of the</u>
- 25 Commonwealth.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
