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## AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting certain conduct in public office; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Abuse of
- 7 Public Office Prohibition and Penalty Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Elected official." An individual elected by the public to
- 13 serve a term in an elective office. The term shall include an
- 14 individual appointed to fill an unexpired term in an elective
- 15 office.
- 16 "Elective office." A position in a governmental body to
- 17 which an individual is required under the Constitution of

- 1 Pennsylvania or by law to be elected by the public.
- "Governmental body." A department, authority, commission,
- 3 committee, council, board, bureau, division, service, office,
- 4 administration, legislative body or other establishment in the
- 5 executive, legislative or judicial branch of the Commonwealth or
- 6 a political subdivision of the Commonwealth.
- 7 "Public contractor." A party to a contract with a
- 8 governmental body or an employee of a party to a contract with a
- 9 governmental body.
- 10 "Public employee." An individual employed by a governmental
- 11 body. An individual elected to a governmental body shall not be
- 12 deemed to be an employee of that governmental body.
- "Public officer." An individual appointed by an elected
- 14 official or a governmental body to serve in a governmental body.
- 15 Section 3. Abuse of office.
- 16 (a) Prohibition. -- It shall be unlawful for an elected
- 17 official or a public officer, or a public employee acting at the
- 18 request of an elected official or public officer, to
- 19 intentionally do any of the following:
- 20 (1) Compel a public employee to perform an activity
- 21 knowing that the activity is not related to the performance
- of the duties of the office held by the elected official or
- 23 public officer.
- 24 (2) Compel a public contractor to provide a good or
- 25 service for the private pecuniary benefit of the elected
- official, public officer or another person. This paragraph
- shall not apply to an attempt to negotiate or enforce the
- 28 terms of a private or public contract.
- 29 (b) Penalty.--
- 30 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), an

- individual found to have committed an offense under
- 2 subsection (a) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second
- 3 degree.
- 4 (2) If the aggregate value of the activities, goods or
- 5 services performed or provided in violation of subsection (a)
- 6 exceeds \$2,000, an offense under this section shall be graded
- 7 a felony of the third degree.
- 8 Section 4. Penalty for false reports.
- 9 An individual who makes a fictitious report or gives false
- 10 information relating to an offense under this act shall be
- 11 guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree.
- 12 Section 5. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
