A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of September 13 through 19, 2015, as "Arts
- in Education Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Arts education comprises a rich array of
- 4 disciplines, including dance, media arts, music, theater, visual
- 5 arts and similar areas of study; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Arts education is a core academic component and an
- 7 essential element of a complete and well-rounded education for
- 8 all students; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Arts education enables students to develop critical
- 10 thinking and problem-solving skills, imagination, creativity,
- 11 discipline, collaboration, cross-cultural understanding and
- 12 alternate ways to communicate and express feelings and ideas,
- 13 all of which support success across the curriculum; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Arts education contributes to increased attendance
- 15 and graduation rates, elevates academic achievement and prepares
- 16 students for college, a career and citizenship readiness; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Arts education contributes to personal growth

- 1 outside the classroom, including an increase in a student's
- 2 likelihood to participate in civic life, volunteerism, altruism
- 3 and community engagement; and
- 4 WHEREAS, To succeed in today's economy, students must
- 5 masterfully develop traits that business leaders demand in a
- 6 21st century workforce, such as communicating through words,
- 7 images, sounds and movement; and
- 8 WHEREAS, There is widespread concern that high-stakes
- 9 testing, accountability measures for educators and reduced
- 10 funding are leading to the reduction of access to arts education
- 11 for students in this Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The arts are an integral part of life in the United
- 13 States and this Commonwealth, as well as an integral part of a
- 14 complete educational experience that contributes to the vibrancy
- 15 and vitality of communities and the nation, therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 17 week of September 13 through 19, 2015, as "Arts in Education
- 18 Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives call on all
- 20 employees and families throughout this Commonwealth to observe
- 21 "Arts in Education Week" with appropriate activities.
