## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 3, 1978 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An 1 act to promote the general welfare and stimulate the economy 2 of the Commonwealth by requiring that all public bodies, 3 including the Commonwealth, its political subdivisions, and all authorities, include in all contracts for construction, 4 5 6 reconstruction, alteration, repair, improvement or maintenance of improvements of a permanent or temporary 7 8 nature, a provision that if any steel products are to be used in the performance of the contract only steel products 9 10 produced in the United States shall be used, and imposing 11 liability for violation of this act," further providing for definitions. 12

- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. The definition of "steel products" in section 6
- 16 of the act of March 3, 1978 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Steel
- 17 Products Procurement Act, amended July 9, 1984 (P.L.674,
- 18 No.144), is amended to read:
- 19 Section 6. The following words and phrases when used in this
- 20 act shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise,
- 21 the meanings given to them in this section:

- 1 "Steel products." Products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn,
- 2 extruded, forged, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly
- 3 processed, or processed by a combination of two or more of such
- 4 operations, from steel made in the United States by the open
- 5 hearth, basic oxygen, electric furnace, Bessemer or other steel
- 6 making process and shall include cast iron products and shall
- 7 include machinery and equipment listed in United States
- 8 Department of Commerce Standard Industrial Classification 25
- 9 (furniture and fixture), 35 (machinery, except electrical) and
- 10 37 (transportation equipment) and made of, fabricated from, or
- 11 containing steel components. If a product contains both foreign
- 12 and United States steel, such product shall be determined to be
- 13 a United States steel product only if at least 75% of the cost
- 14 of the articles, materials and supplies have been mined,
- 15 produced or manufactured, as the case may be, in the United
- 16 States. Transportation equipment shall be determined to be a
- 17 United States steel product if it complies with section 165 of
- 18 Public Law 97-424 (96 Stat. 2136). The term includes products
- 19 made from recycled steel if the steel was in previous use in the
- 20 United States, the steel was rerolled in the United States and
- 21 the product was manufactured in the United States.

- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
